2018 ARS Tenarky District Rose Show

Millington, TN - October 13, 2018

The grooming area will open at **1:00 AM**. Exhibitors will place their own entries from **6:00 AM** until **9:30 AM** being careful not to touch or move another entry. Rose Show personnel will be available to assist exhibitors as needed. Challenge Class Entries are not to be touched by anyone except the entrant.

Cash Prizes, Trophies, Certificates and Ribbons (if desired) may be picked up Saturday, October 13, 2018 at **4:00 PM** except prizes for the Three (3) Major Tenarky District Challenge Classes (Designated with an asterisk *) and Queens of Show (Hybrid Tea, Floribunda Spray, Dowager, Shrub, Victorian, Miniature and Miniflora) which will be presented at the Awards Banquet Saturday evening.

RULES

1. Except for District Challenge Classes, competition is open to all rose growers registered for the Convention regardless of residence. ARS Tenarky District Challenge Classes Section B Classes 2 – 16 are open only to exhibitors who are members of the Tenarky District. The Portland National Challenge Class Section A Class 1 is open only to ARS members with an ARS Membership Expiration Date after October 14, 2018 who are registered for the convention.
2. Entries are judged by ARS accredited and/or ARS apprentice judges according to ARS Guidelines and Rules for Judging Roses and other show conditions as set forth in this Rose Show Schedule. Only Blue Ribbon Winners are eligible for Awards. The point scale at the bottom of the Rose Show Rules will be incorporated into the judging of the roses in accordance to ARS Rules and Regulations. Particular attention should be paid to reasons for disqualification (DQ) as listed in these guidelines and below.
3. Entries are to be placed from **6:00 am until 9:30 AM** on October 13, 2018. Only one exhibitor or team per garden is permitted and rose(s) **MUST** be outdoor grown. Judging will commence promptly at 9:45 AM and is anticipated to conclude at approximately 12:30 PM (or earlier) at which time the rose show will be open to the general public. The decision(s) of the judges is final. The Rose Show Committee will furnish all containers except as specifically noted in the Rose Show Schedule. Each entry must be accompanied by a securely folded ARS Entry Tag(s) completed with Section, Class, Variety and Exhibitor Name(s), address and Convention (Exhibitor) Registration Number(s). Both top and Bottom portions of the ARS Entry Tag need be completed. Only Pencil, Blue or Black ink, Stamp with Blue or Black ink or Printed Name Labels may be used.
4. Wedging of green Styrofoam only is permitted; however, an entry may be penalized if the wedging extends above the lip of the vase according to the degree of distraction.
5. With the exception of Seedlings and Sports, rose varieties exhibited must be entered under the approved exhibition name adopted by the American Rose Society as listed in any one of the following official ARS publications: Modern Roses 12 (Book and Data Base), The Official List of Approved Exhibition Names for Judges and Exhibitors, The Handbook for Selecting Roses, or Recent Registrations on the ARS web site. In instances where a variety is not listed in any of the above listed ARS publications, a listing in the **2018** Combined Rose List is acceptable.
6. With the exception of Challenge Classes and classes specifying multiple varieties, all roses in each class will be placed alphabetically and each variety in each class shall constitute a separate class to be judged separately. During judging, only the Horticultural, Arrangement and Photography Chairs, Judges and Clerks will be permitted in the Rose Show Area.

7. With the exception of Seedling and Sports, all entries become the property of the Memphis & Dixie Rose Society and will either be sold off at the conclusion of the Rose Show or donated to local hospitals and nursing homes.
8. ARS Certificates, M & D Certificates and Cash Prizes will be awarded as set forth in the Rose Show Schedule.

Reasons for Disqualification

- a. Misnamed, Misclassified, misplaced by the exhibitor, unlabeled, partially labeled or mislabeled,
- b. Stem on Stem which is a specimen exhibited with a portion of the previous stem growth attached. Exception: Old Garden Roses and Shrub roses may be shown Stem on Stem but, only with one dog leg.
- c. Presence of foreign substance applied to the foliage, stem or bloom to improve the appearance of the specimen.
- d. Not disbudded. Any class calling for a one-bloom per stem specimen must be exhibited without side buds. A side bud is defined as growth emanating from a leaf axil and having sufficient maturity to display the formation of a stem with or without flower buds. The presence of one or more leaves at the leaf axil with no evidence of a stem is cause for penalization according to the degree of distraction but, not disqualification. Exception: Species, Old Garden Roses, Climbers and Shrub one bloom per stem specimens may be exhibited with side buds.
- e. An entry in violation of ARS rules or local society rules applying to this rose show.
- f. Any rose that has been entered in this show with a name that has not been recognized by the American Rose Society will be disqualified. Roses are to be exhibited with the recognized ARS exhibition name (AEN).

National Challenge Class

Entries are open only to registered exhibitors of the Rose Show who are members of the **American Rose Society** regardless of residence. ARS Membership ID will be required. Limit of one (1) entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Space will be assigned by lottery. Exhibitors place entries. 36" width space limitation.

Section A.

Class 1. Portland "City of Roses" National Traveling Trophy - An entry of **five (5)** roses of **five (5)** different varieties to be staged in separate vases with separate entry tags. The entry is to consist of a minimum of **two (2)** Sprays. The Prizes and Awards Committee of the American Rose Society has approved the wording of this Challenge Class which is open to any **ARS member** holding current membership as of October 14, 2018 regardless of residence.

Tenarky District Rose Show Challenge Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show who are members of the **Tenarky District**. Limit of **one (1)** entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Space will be assigned by lottery. Exhibitors place entries. 18" width space limitation. All winning entries will receive M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section B.

Class 2*. The ARS J. Horace **McFarland** District Award – **Five (5)** Hybrid Tea roses, one bloom per stem, each a **different variety** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tenarky District)

Class 3. The Mack and Marybeth **Blackburn** District Award – **Four (4)** Hybrid Tea roses, one bloom per stem, each a **different variety** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate (Sponsored by the Nashville Rose Society)

Class 4. The Kent **Campbell** District Award – **Four (4)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora roses, one bloom per stem, each a **different color class** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Bowling Green Rose Society)

Class 5. The Robert and Glenda **Whitaker** District Award – **Four (4)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora roses, one bloom per stem, each a **different variety** from the **Pink and/or Pink Blend color class** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Nashville Rose Society)

Class 6. The Charles **Dawson** Memorial Award – **Three (3)** Hybrid Tea roses, one bloom per stem, each a **different variety** from the **RED color class** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Louisville Rose Society)

Class 7. Peggy & Mary Jane **Utz** Memorial Award – **Three (3)** Miniature sprays (Miniflora roses are excluded), **the same or different varieties**, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Louisville Rose Society)

Class 8. The Monty **Justice** Memorial Award – **Three (3)** specimens, from the classes of Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora, Floribunda, OGR and Shrub roses, **any combination** of one bloom per stem at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Louisville Rose Society)

Class 9. Lester **Smith** District Challenge Award – Three (3) specimens, either Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora roses, **all the same variety** shown in one (1) container. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tri-State Rose Society)

Class 10. Jimmy & Evelyn **Moser** District Award – **Three (3)** Shrub roses (Classic and/or Modern), the **same or different varieties**, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Memphis & Dixie Rose Society)

Class 11*. The ARS Ralph **Moore** District Award – **Seven (7)** Miniature roses (Miniflora roses are excluded), one bloom per stem, each a **different variety** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tenarky District)

Class 12. The Whit Wells District Award – **Five (5)** Miniflora roses (Miniature roses are excluded), one bloom per stem, each a **different variety** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Memphis & Dixie Rose Society)

Class 13*. The Tenarky District Director Challenge – **Seven (7)** Miniflora roses (Miniature roses are excluded) one bloom to a stem, each a **different variety** at exhibition stage, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tenarky District)

Class 14. The Tenarky District **Grandiflora** Challenge Award – **Two (2)** Grandiflora roses, **one bloom** per stem and/or **Sprays**, each a **different variety**, shown in **one container**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tenarky District)

Class 15. The Tenarky District **Floribunda** Challenge Award – **Three (3)** Floribunda roses, **one bloom** per stem and/or **spray**, each a **different variety**, shown in **one container**. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate

Class 16. Large **Basket** Challenge Award – An entry of not more than **twenty four (24)** roses from Hybrid Tea, Floribunda, Shrub and OGR roses at any stage without side buds, **any combination of the above rose classes and/or varieties**, exhibited in a basket supplied by the exhibitor. Floral foam permitted. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tenarky District)

Class 17. Small **Basket** Challenge Award – An entry of not more than **twenty four (24)** roses from Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha roses at any stage without side buds, **any combination of the above rose classes and/or varieties**, exhibited in a basket supplied by the exhibitor. Floral foam permitted. Cash Prize & Tenarky District Certificate. (Sponsored by the Tenarky District)

Tenarky District – Large Rose Challenge Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. Limit of one entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Exhibitors place entries. 18” width space limitation. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section C.

Class 18. Small Garden Challenge Class – Limited to those exhibitors growing fifty (50) or less total roses. **Five (5) Roses from any Classifications. One** bloom per stem or Sprays, the **same or different varieties**, shown in **one (1) container**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 19. Five Same or Different Large Rose Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora roses, one bloom per stem, the **same or different variety**, shown in **one (1) container**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 20. Three Same or Different Floribunda Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Floribunda roses, one bloom per stem, the **same or different variety**, shown in **one (1) container**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 21. Three OGR Challenge Class – **Three (3)** OGR roses, **one bloom** per stem or **sprays**, the **same or different varieties**, Dowager and/or Victorian, shown in **separate containers**. Date of Introduction **must** appear on the entry tag above the cultivar name. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 22. Three Shrub Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Shrub roses, **one bloom** per stem or **sprays**, the **same or different varieties**, classic or modern shrubs, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 23. Three Polyantha Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Polyantha rose sprays, the **same or different varieties**, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 24. Artist Palette Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora, Floribunda or Shrub rose blooms at exhibition stage, each a **different variety**, representative of colors used by an artist. **Exhibitors may use their own palette**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 25. Hi – Lo Challenge Class – **One (1)** bloom per stem Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora or Floribunda rose and **one (1)** bloom per stem Miniature or Miniflora rose matched as closely as possible for form and color shown in **separate containers**. **Cash Prize & ARS Certificate**

Class 26. English Box Hybrid Tea Challenge Class – **Six (6)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora or Floribunda roses without foliage, of the **same variety** or three **different varieties** of two (2) each, at exhibition stage. **Exhibitors may use their own English Box.** Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 27. Stages of Bloom Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora blooms of the **same variety** representative of the three distinct stages of development. One bloom should be approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ open just beginning to unfurl with sepals down, one bloom should be at exhibition stage $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ open and one bloom should be fully open with stamens showing, exhibited in **separate containers.** Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 28. Rose in a Bowl Challenge Class – **One (1)** Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora or Floribunda rose at exhibition stage floating in clear water in a bowl furnished by the Memphis & Dixie Rose Society. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 29. Picture Frame Hybrid Tea Challenge Class - **One (1)** Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora or Floribunda bloom exhibited in an $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 picture frame. **Exhibitors may use their own picture frames.** Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Tenarky District – Miniature Rose Challenge Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. Limit of one entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Exhibitors place entries. 18” width space limitation. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section D.

Class 30. Five Same or Different Miniature Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Miniature, (excludes miniflora roses) one bloom per stem, the **same or different** variety, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 31. Three Same or Different Miniature Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Miniature rose Sprays, (excludes miniflora roses) **same or different** varieties, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 32. Artist Palette Miniature Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Miniature rose blooms at exhibition stage, (excludes miniflora roses) each a **different variety**, representative of colors used by an artist. **Exhibitors may use their own palette**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 33. Miniature English Box – **Six (6)** Miniature roses without foliage, of the **same** variety, at exhibition stage. **Exhibitors may use their own English Boxes**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 34. Stages of Bloom Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Miniature rose blooms of the **same variety** representative of the three distinct stages of development. One bloom should be approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ open just beginning to unfurl with sepals down, one bloom should be at exhibition stage $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ open and one bloom should be fully open with stamens showing, exhibited in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 35. Rose in a Bowl Challenge Class – **One (1)** Miniature rose without foliage, at exhibition stage, floating in clear water in a bowl furnished by the Memphis & Dixie Rose Society Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 36. Picture Frame **Miniature** or **Miniflora** Challenge Class - **One (1)** Miniature bloom or **One (1)** Miniflora bloom with or without foliage exhibited in an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 picture frame. **Exhibitors may use their own picture frames**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Tenarky District – Miniflora Rose Challenge Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. Limit of one entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Exhibitors place entries. 18” width space limitation. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section E.

Class 37. Five Same or Different Miniflora Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Miniflora roses, (excludes miniature roses) one bloom per stem, the **same or different** variety, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 38. Three Same or Different Miniflora Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Miniflora rose Sprays, (excludes miniature roses) **same or different** varieties, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 39. Artist Palette Miniflora Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Miniflora roses at exhibition stage, (excludes miniature roses) each a **different** variety, representative of colors used by an artist. **Exhibitors may use their own palette**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 40. Hi – Lo Challenge Class – **One (1)** bloom per stem **Miniflora** rose and **One (1)** bloom per stem **Miniature** rose matched as closely as possible for form and color, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 41. Miniflora English Box – **Six (6)** Miniflora roses without foliage, of the same variety, at exhibition stage. **Exhibitors may use their own English Boxes** Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 42. Stages of Bloom Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Miniflora rose blooms of the **same variety** representative of the three distinct stages of development. One bloom should be approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ open just beginning to unfurl with sepals down, one bloom should be at exhibition stage $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ open and one bloom should be fully open with stamens showing, exhibited in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 43. Rose in a Bowl Challenge Class. **One (1)** Miniflora rose without foliage, at exhibition stage, floating in clear water in a bowl furnished by the Memphis & Dixie Rose Society. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Tenarky District – Large Roses – Single Stem Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. No limit on entries per exhibitor except only one entry per exhibitor of a cultivar. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section F.

Class 44. Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora and their Climbing Counterparts – **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best **six (6)** blue ribbon winning roses are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and Court**. Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess plus 3 M & D Certificates

Class 45. Novice Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora and their Climbing Counterparts – **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best blue ribbon winner will be awarded **Novice Queen**. All Novice blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Class 44 Queen of Show**. A Novice is an exhibitor who has **NEVER** won a blue ribbon in any class at an ARS sanctioned rose show. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate & Trophy

Class 46. Open Bloom – **One (1)** bloom per stem Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora rose fully open with stamens showing. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 47. Spray – **One (1)** stem Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora rose with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 48. Floribunda Bloom – **One (1)** bloom per stem Floribunda at exhibition stage without side buds. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 49. Floribunda Spray – **One (1)** stem Floribunda with two (2) or more blooms. The best **six (6)** blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and Court**. **Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess plus 3 M & D Certificates**

Class 50. Polyantha Spray – **One (1)** stem Polyantha with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 51. Climbers – **One (1)** stem of a Large-Flowered Climber, Hybrid Wichurana or Hybrid Gigantea with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 52. Single Roses – **One (1)** stem of any type of rose (exclusive of Miniature or Miniflora) having four (4) to eight (8) petals and/or classified as a single. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 53. Classic Shrub – **One (1)** bloom or spray from the classes of roses of Hybrid Musk, Hybrid Rugosa, Hybrid Moyesii or Kordesii. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 54. Modern Shrub – **One (1)** Shrub Spray with two (2) or more blooms. The best **six (6)** blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and Court.** Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess plus 3 M & D Certificates

Class 55. Old Garden Roses (**Dowager Queen**) - **One (1)** bloom or spray of an Old Garden Rose introduced before 1867 including roses of unknown dates known to have been in existence prior to 1867. Date of Introduction **must** appear above the cultivar name on the ARS Entry Tag. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 56. Old Garden Roses (**Victorian Award**) – **One (1)** bloom or spray of an Old Garden Rose introduced in 1867 or after including roses of unknown dates known to have been in existence in 1867 or after. Date of introduction **must** appear above the cultivar name on the ARS Entry Tag. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 57. Species Roses (**Genesis Award**) – One (1) bloom or spray of a rose designated in ARS publications as a Species Rose (Sp). Date of introduction **must** appear above the cultivar name on the ARS Entry Tag. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 58. Seedling or Sport of Hybrid Tea, Floribunda, Grandiflora, Shrub or old Garden Rose – An unregistered seedling or Sport hybridized or found by the exhibitor. Parentage is to be listed on entry tag. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 59. Seedling or Sport of Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha rose – An unregistered seedling or sport hybridized or found by the exhibitor. Parentage is to be listed on entry tag. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Tenarky District – Miniature Roses – Single Stem Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. No limit on entries per exhibitor except only one entry per exhibitor of a cultivar. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section G.

Class 60. Miniature – **One (1)** bloom per stem at exhibition stage. The best six (6) blue ribbon winning roses are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and court.** **Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificate plus 3 M & D Certificates**

Class 61. Miniature Novice - **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best blue ribbon winner will be awarded **Miniature Novice Queen.** All Miniature Novice blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Class 60 Miniature Queen of Show.** A Novice is an exhibitor who has **NEVER** won a blue ribbon in any class at an ARS sanctioned rose show. **Cash Prize & ARS Certificate & Trophy**

Class 62. Miniature Open Bloom – **One (1)** Bloom per stem of a fully open bloom with stamens showing. **Cash Prize & ARS Certificate**

Class 63. Miniature Spray – **One (1)** spray with two (2) or more blooms. **Cash Prize & M & D Certificate**

Class 64. Miniature Single – **One (1)** bloom classified as a single with four (4) to eight (8) petals and/or classified as a single. **Cash Prize & M & D Certificate**

Tenarky District – Miniflora Roses – Single Stem Classes

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. No limit on entries per exhibitor except only one entry per exhibitor of a cultivar. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or M & D RS Certificates and Cash Prizes.

Section H.

Class 65. Miniflora – **One (1)** bloom per stem at exhibition stage. The best six (6) blue ribbon winning roses are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and court.** Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificates plus 3 M & D Certificates

Class 66. Miniflora Novice - **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best blue ribbon winner will be awarded **Miniflora Novice Queen.** All Miniflora Novice blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Class 65 Miniflora Queen of Show.** A Novice is an exhibitor who has **NEVER** won a blue ribbon in any class at an ARS sanctioned rose show. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate & Trophy

Class 67. Miniflora Open Bloom – **One (1)** Bloom per stem of a fully open bloom with stamens showing. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

Class 68. Miniflora Spray – **One (1)** spray with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 69. Miniflora Single – **One (1)** bloom classified as a single with four (4) to eight (8) petals and/or classified as a single. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Tenarky District – Judges Class

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Tenarky District Rose Show who are not exhibiting in Class 1 through and including Class 69. There is a limit on the total number of entries of four (4) roses per class for Class 70 through and including Class 73 that a judge may make. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive Memphis & Dixie Rose Society Certificates. The **Best Entry** from Class 70 through and including Class 73 will receive an ARS certificate.

Section I.

Class 70. Judges Large Rose Exhibition Class – One (1) bloom per stem, at exhibition stage, of Hybrid Tea, Floribunda, Shrub and OGR rose. Limit of four (4) entries per judge. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 71. Judges Small Rose Exhibition Class – One (1) bloom per stem, at exhibition stage, of Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha rose. Limit of four (4) entries per Judge. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 72. Judges Large Rose Spray Class – One (1) spray with two or more blooms of Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora, Floribunda, Shrub and OGR rose. Limit of four (4) entries per judge. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Class 73. Judges Small Rose Spray Class – One (1) spray with two or more blooms of Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha rose. Limit of four (4) entries per judge. Cash Prize & M & D Certificate

Note: Best of Show – To be selected from all of the winning entries on the honors table. All (7) judges will vote for the Best of Show Award. Four votes out of seven are necessary to win Best of Show. Cash Prize
